If you are 60 years of age or above, we invite you to a wonderful event Friday, June 11! We will be celebrating



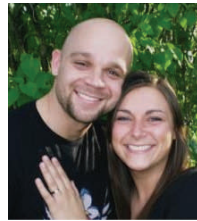

# Today's Note

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace...(Galatians 5.22)

Does the way you live identify you as a Christian? During this year, church members are asked to show the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5.22, 23). This third month into our series, we add to love and joy, the third fruit of the Spirit, which is peace.

Isaiah wrote, Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Peace is an abiding awareness of the deep resources of God's grace, and the Spirit that works within us. It is the fruit of the Spirit that makes for an untroubled heart in a troubled world.

During the winter in the North Atlantic, violent storms rage with wind and waves coming against anything in their path. Great ocean vessels weighing a million tons, are seen tossed about like small chips of wood. Meanwhile, icebergs in the Atlantic stand like majestic white castles, unaffected by the heaving sea and howling wind. They are defiant of the mighty waves hurled against their towering walls and glistening heads. They stand unmoved because their lower part is deep in the ocean where there is calm. Only one-ninth of an iceberg is above the ocean's surface.



When our lives are hidden in Jesus Christ, the storms of life are powerless to take from us the peace we have in Him. God does not always still the storm without, but He does still the storm within. Christians should show peace in their lives.
