# Today's Note

## We Preach Christ Crucified

Throughout history, men and women are remembered for their great accomplishments. We remember George Washington for being the first president; Blaise Pascal for his mathematics and philosophy; Alexander Graham Bell for inventing the telephone; Madam Curie for her work with radioactivity; Joseph Lister for pioneering antiseptic surgery; Elizabeth Barrett Browning as a great writer; Thomas Edison for the invention of the incandescent light; and Nathaniel Hawthorne who wrote The Scarlet Letter; just to name a few.

These men and women, and countless others, will forever be remembered for their great accomplishments which represent the zenith of their lives' achievements.

Jesus secured His place in history early in His ministry. As many as 40 miracles of Christ are carefully recorded in the Gospels, and each one would have brought Him fame. The changing of the water to wine, the healing of the man born blind, the curing of the demoniac, the calming of the storm on the Sea of Galilee, feeding of the 5,000; not to mention the miracles of His resurrection and Ascension.

But none of these were His greatest accomplishments.

The great Apostle Paul declared that while the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom, we preach Christ crucified.

That is the greatest accomplishment of Jesus Christ, or of anyone that ever lived. The preaching of Christ crucified proves the holiness of God, reveals the awfulness of sin, and demonstrates the grace of God.

In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; (Ephesians 1.7).
